TENANT ENGAGEMENT HIGHLIGHTS 2023/24

Over the last year, Radius have invested over £80,000 in Tenant Engagement projects, initiatives, support and training for our tenants, with almost half of this going to Community Chest grants.

Some of the areas that have benefitted from this investment include:

Community Chest

The Community Chest Fund 2023-24 has now closed, supporting 43 projects within Radius communities with a total of £33,296.58. These projects aim to boost community development and improve the health and wellbeing of tenants and local communities.

Estate Walkabouts

As part of our commitment to improving our neighbourhoods Radius staff carried out Estate Walkabouts in 39 Radius communities with 192 tenants getting involved in identifying issues that require attention in Radius Communities.

Tenant Panels

Our tenants' voices were heard loud and clear—from doorstep to boardroom—through Panel and Tenant Executive Committee Meetings, Service Improvement Groups, and Consultations.

In total, we held 20 meetings face to face and online with 120 participants, who volunteered 425 hours of their time.

Tenant Approved

11 tenant-approved documents which included letters, leaflets, and publications ensuring that tenants were involved in the content and design of Tenant Approved communications.
