### Let's Grow

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It doesn't matter how small your outdoor space is, there's always an opportunity to grow your own vegetables and fruit, even on a patio, balcony or windowsill.

Growing your own plants from seed has several advantages. You have a wider choice of varieties, because commercially raised plants are normally restricted to a few popular varieties. If you don't have a greenhouse or propagator, it's going to be easier to buy ready grown plants and buy what you need. Certain plants are easy to grow from seed; courgettes, peas, lettuces, spinach, beetroot, and bean seeds can be sown directly into a pot or container.

#### Positioning

Most containers of plants find a south-facing position too intense, because it can get too hot. Position your containers a few feet away from the wall in hot spots, or find bright positions that get several hours of sun rather than all-day sun and ensure they are getting enough water during the day.
