What is Gnangara Housing with Care?

Gnangara Fold provides Residential Care services to Residents in accordance with the contractual arrangements in place between the Western Health and Social Care Trust and Radius Housing Association.

Gnangara provides Residential care in agreement with the Resident, their family and the health and social care professionals who may be involved in assisting decisions on suitability of residential care in meeting individual needs.

A key aim of residential care is to ensure each individual's needs are met whilst also promoting

each individual resident's independence.

Gnangara will develop a person centred care plan to meet each resident's individual needs. This care and support plan will be agreed with the Resident following admission and will be reviewed and evaluated as and when required to ensure the service we provide will continue to meet your actual needs and aspirations.

Gnangara welcomes the involvement of each Resident, their family, Next-of-kin, and health professionals in creating a care plan that will best meet each Resident's needs.

Services provided can include:

- Assistance and/or support with personal care and dressing
- Assistance with the management of medication
- Provision of meals catered to dietary requirements, likes and dislikes
- Provision of Laundry service
- Support to arrange appointments for hairdressing service
- Support to arrange appointments for Podiatry and Optician services

Local arrangements and costs for hairdressing, Podiatry and Optician services are available from the Registered Manager and/or the Senior Care Team.

Should you require further information on the services provided and the charges applicable to Gnangara before deciding if Residential Care is right for you, please contact the Registered Manager who will answer any queries you may have.

Further information is included in the Residents' Handbook which can be made available to you on request.

HOW DO YOU APPLY?

Applications for Gngangara can be obtained from Gngangara, or from Radius House, 3, Redburn Square, Holywood BT18 9HZ, telephone number 0330 123 0888.

The Registered Manager will undertake an assessment of need on receipt of referral/application and prior to an offer of accommodation being made. This is to ensure that Gngangara can meet your needs and that you are confident and content that Gngangara is the right choice for you.

OTHER SERVICES PROVIDED:

- Helping you to feel safe and secure in your home at Gngangara.
- Assisting you to engage with healthcare professionals and others in the interests of your health and wellbeing
- Providing you with advice and/or assistance with personal budgeting, paying bills and household expenses
- Responding to emergency alarm calls from your dwelling on a 24/7 basis
- Providing you with assistance to maintain your home

- Providing a household cleaning service to your dwelling
- Arranging adaptations, if needed, to your dwelling to enable you to maintain your independence

Gnangara is registered with The Regulation and Quality Improvement Authority to provide residential care to older people and those with a diagnosis of dementia who will benefit from living in a safe and secure environment.

Gnangara is a locked door environment. Access to and from the scheme is managed through a door access system.

The Registered Manager and her Team at Gnangara hope that this brochure will provide you with enough information to assist you and your family in making the best choice for you.
