Wishing you a Safe & Happy Christmas



At Radius we want to make sure that you are safe this Christmas and YOU can help. **Look after YOU**

- Keep a stock of basic food items and basic cold/flu remedies.
- Order repeat prescriptions in advance.
- Keep your mobile phone charged and topped-up.
- Wrap up warm & wear suitable clothing when going outdoors, only going out in severe weather if you need to.
- Have at least one warm meal a day.
- Be aware of scams, if its sounds too good to be true it probably is.

Look after YOUR HOME

- Know how to turn off your water, gas and electricity.
- Make sure windows and doors are closed to reduce draughts.
- Lock your doors and windows when leaving your home and before bed.
- Make sure Christmas lights carry the British Safety Standard sign.
- Don't leave candles unattended or close to materials that than can catch fire quickly.
- Don't attach decorations to lights or heaters, they can catch fire easily.
- Never overload electrical sockets.
- Always switch off Christmas lights and unplug them before you go to bed.
- Make sure presents are not visible through windows.

Look after EACH OTHER

- Check in on each other, particularly those who are vulnerable.
- Make sure you and your visitors know how to escape in an emergency.
- Make sure you close your communal front door securely when coming in/out.
- Check communal windows and doors are secure at night.
- Don't prop open fire doors.
- Be vigilant of those who are visiting your community.
- If you notice anything suspicious PULL YOUR CORD or call the PSNI on 101 (non-emergency) or 999 (emergency).
