If you and your partner are over state retirement age you may be entitled to Pension Credit, even if you think you aren't entitled please request a benefits check. Pension Credit helps pay for your living costs.

Radius has 3 dedicated in-house Welfare Advice Officers engaging with our tenants daily providing advice, guidance, information & advocacy on all elements of benefit entitlement.
