Radius First in NI to Achieve Tenant Participation Accreditation

Tenant Participation Accreditation recognises landlords who demonstrate excellence in tenant participation. The process was designed by Supporting Communities as the Independent Tenant Organisation for NI who carried out an in-depth assessment.

Radius underwent a 5 stage process, this included 363 pieces of documentary evidence, two focus groups (one with tenants) and an independent evaluation of the procedures and practices used by Radius.

Following the rigorous assessment Sheenagh McNally from Supporting communities said "Radius Housing has made significant strides in engaging tenants over the last 4 years since the merger in 2017, there are excellent examples of good practice throughout the submission that can be described as **sector leading**."

John McLean, Chief Executive said "We are delighted to be the first NI based recipient of the assessment and to win the much coveted **Silver Award.** However more importantly we look forward to enhancing our partnership by implementing the positive recommendations from the assessment panel."
