## FUND YOUR 2025 PROJECTS WITH COMMUNITY CHEST



The Radius Community Chest 2024-25 is still open for groups to apply for funding from £250-£1000.

So far this year we have funded 22 projects totalling £15,000. Projects have varied and included schemes applying for gardening equipment and furniture, games for the common room such as boccia and bingo equipment, board games and arts & crafts workshops.

At Christmas time residents in Portglenone successfully received funding to attend the Cinderella Panto Theatre at the Mill Newtownabbey, for many of them this was the first time at the panto and a great opportunity for neighbours to get together in a fun environment. At the end of January, Storm Éowyn battered the UK and Ireland, leaving behind a trail of destruction.

### **TENANT SURVEY** & RESEARCH 2025

Radius Housing have asked an independent research agency Service Insights to carry out a large-scale satisfaction survey in February and March to collect feedback from tenants on the services we provide.

The survey should take about 10 minutes to complete, and tenants will be randomly selected to participate.

Following feedback from tenants we are going to organise a Service Improvement Group to review our **Response Repairs contracts, which** started in Septemer 2023.

This group will consist of tenants and staff who work together to generate ideas and suggestions with the aim of making improvements and managing expectations.

On Tuesday 18th February at 11am, Tenant Engagement will host an information session, via Microsoft Teams, giving an overview on the Response Contracts and what is expected as part of the Service Improvement Group.
