As the previous edition was last printed in 2018, it was well overdue for a refresh!

Information has been reviewed and updated to reflect current policies, services and legislation, ensuring tenants have access to accurate and up-to-date guidance.

Content has been rewritten in plain, straightforward language, making it easier to understand and more accessible for all readers.

The handbook has been shaped by a working group of staff and tenants collaborating throughout the last six months of 2025.

Support will be available to tenants who may need help accessing the digital version and individual sections of the handbook can be printed on request.

Also undergoing a makeover is the Radius website which has been redeveloped with our tenants and customers front of mind.

The layout and design of both the handbook and website have been enhanced with improved structures and signposting, making it quicker and easier for tenants to find the relevant information they require such as repairs, rent and responsibilities plus access to support services.

Before the website goes live in early 2026, the Tenant Executive Committee will be involved in testing and reviewing, helping ensure it will be user friendly for every visitor.

Finally, 2026 will see the launch of our first ever digital tenant magazine. Every Radius tenant will have access to the new **Your Place** magazine.

Your Place will complement the monthly Radius Mail newsletter, and feature key updates on strategic developments across Radius communities, planned maintenance and redecoration works, as well as useful information about the range of services we provide.

In line with Radius' commitment to being more environmentally friendly, the updated Handbook and Your Place will be available primarily in a digital format as we work to reduce paper use.

Digital Skills Training

We continue to help tenants and residents to become more digitally savvy and confident online.

Since 2023, we have been working closely with AbilityNet, a local charity that supports people to get online and develop digital skills.

To date, they have delivered digital skills training to 163 tenants, either one-to-one or in small groups.

The training covers a range of practical skills, including using tablets and smartphones, shopping online safely, and using social media.

Our Volunteer Digital Champion is available to provide 1-to-1 digital support



for those who need extra guidance.

Food Safety Awareness

Last year we organised a Food Safety & Hygiene Awareness Training course, with 11 tenants from various schemes participating in this pilot.

The course was specifically designed to equip tenants with essential knowledge and skills required to safely support events within Radius schemes.

Feedback from participants was very positive and subject to demand we may run this course again in the spring.

Anyone interested in attending a future Food Safety & Hygiene Awareness Training course should speak with their Scheme Coordinator or Housing Officer.
