TENANT ENGAGEMENT HIGHLIGHTS 2023

Over £20,000 was awarded to empower 30 groups within Radius Communities via the Community Chest Fund.

CIH Award 2023 Tenant Engagement More than Bricks and Mortar.

Our tenants' voices were heard from doorstep to Boardroom by attending Panel and Tenant Executive Committee Meetings, Service Improvement Groups and Consultations with 26 meetings and 65 participants volunteering 309 hrs.

Estate Walkabouts were carried out in Radius Communities engaging with 174 tenants working together to find solutions on 179 issues.

15 Tenant Approved letters, leaflets and publications were developed in consultation with our tenants.

3 Service Improvement Groups involving Complaints, Anti-Social Behaviour and MTC Heating and Hot Water Contract.

PERFECT HANGING BASKETS

Each month, Idverde, our Grounds
Maintenance Contractors are going to
provide tenants with help and suggestions
to brighten up your garden. This month's
topic is: "The Perfect Hanging Baskets".

- 1. **Use some peat free compost** some have feed already mixed in and will indicate how long it lasts; or you can add plant food as instructed.
- 2. You can choose to create a mixed floral basket or choose a selection of the same plants for your hanging basket such as petunias.
- 3. For a mixed basket, **plant a taller plant in the centre** such as a fuschia, petunia, geranium or perhaps a dwarf dahlia.



- 4. Follow this by **arranging trailing and bedding plants around the edge** such as lobelia, allysum, surfinia, ivy, million bells, salvia, begonia or marigold.
- 5. Make sure to **keep your hanging basket moist** and if it doesn't rain through the day give it a water in the evening so the sun doesn't dry them out.
