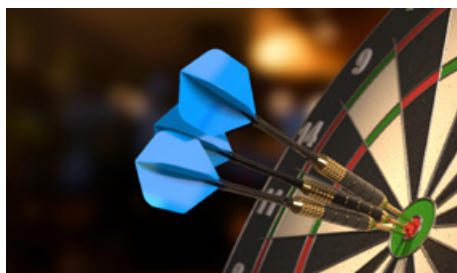
We are delighted to launch the very first Radius Housing Tenants & Residents Darts Competition!

Power of Attorney Protection

In March 2026, consumer champion Martin Lewis delivered a message "Power of Attorney is arguably more important than a Will".

It is important to remember that incapacity can happen to anyone at any time for example by accident or through illness.

An enduring Power of Attorney (an EPA) allows you to choose a person or persons to deal with your property and affairs.

Your Attorney must act in your best interests.

Having an Enduring Power of Attorney set up in advance can make things much easier.

While many people prioritise protecting their estate after they pass away, a Lasting Power of Attorney is the only legal document that protects you and your family while you are still alive.

Any solicitor can provide advice and the Office of Care and Protection can supply general guidance.
